Ferries in Troms use the payment system AutoPASS

Upon boarding, the ferry crew takes a picture of the vehicle's registration number and measures its length. This information is used to determine if the vehicle has an AutoPASS tag, an AutoPASS advance agreement, or is linked to FerryPay.

FerryPay

If you don't have an AutoPASS agreement, you can use FerryPay. We recommend using FerryPay if you are a tourist travelling by ferry in Norway. FerryPay is an automatic card payment for ferry journeys. With FerryPay, you avoid receiving invoices for each journey and can easily pay the full price before boarding.

Debit or credit card

It's only possible to pay with a contactless credit/debit card. If you pay by credit/debit card, you will pay the full price for the ferry journey. Please note that you will not receive an electric car price if you use a bank- or credit card. You will have to pay the same price as regular fossil/hybrid vehicles. If you want the electric car price you will have to pay with Ferrypay. This also applies if you don't have a contactless card.

All prices are for a one-way ferry crossing.
